Key Connective	Suggested Action
Once upon a time Long long ago	Open hands like a book.
Early one morning	Hands to one side of head and pretend to wake up.

### Suggested actions specific to Cat, Bramble and Heron

Cat	Fingers brush imaginary whiskers on side of face.
Bramble	Hand to mouth, 2 fingers pointing straight out as forked tongue
Heron/flew	Hands extended to side, flapping as wings.
Slithered	Palms together making snake movements.
Rusty old pot	Cupped hands make sphere shape.
Sneaked/crept	Fingers of one hand creep over flattened palm of other.
Fishbone	Pinch thumb and index finger as if holding fish skeleton by tail, wrinkle nose at imagined smell.
Pot/bags of gold	Mime counting out coins.
Divided	Hand makes chopping motion on flattened palm of other hand

Beak	Extend hand and makes opening/ closing motion in front of mouth
