Cut-out Snowmen

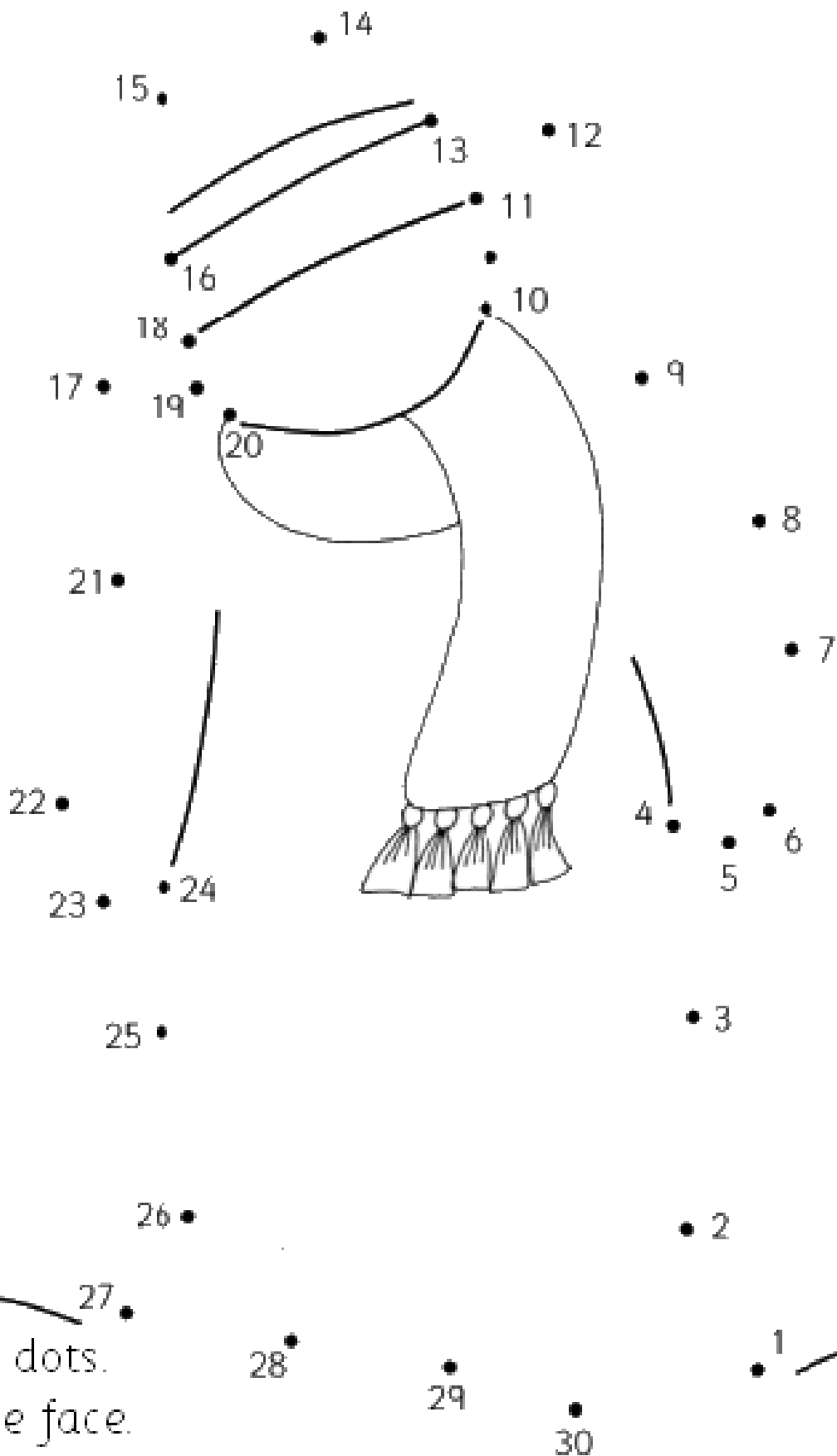
You will need

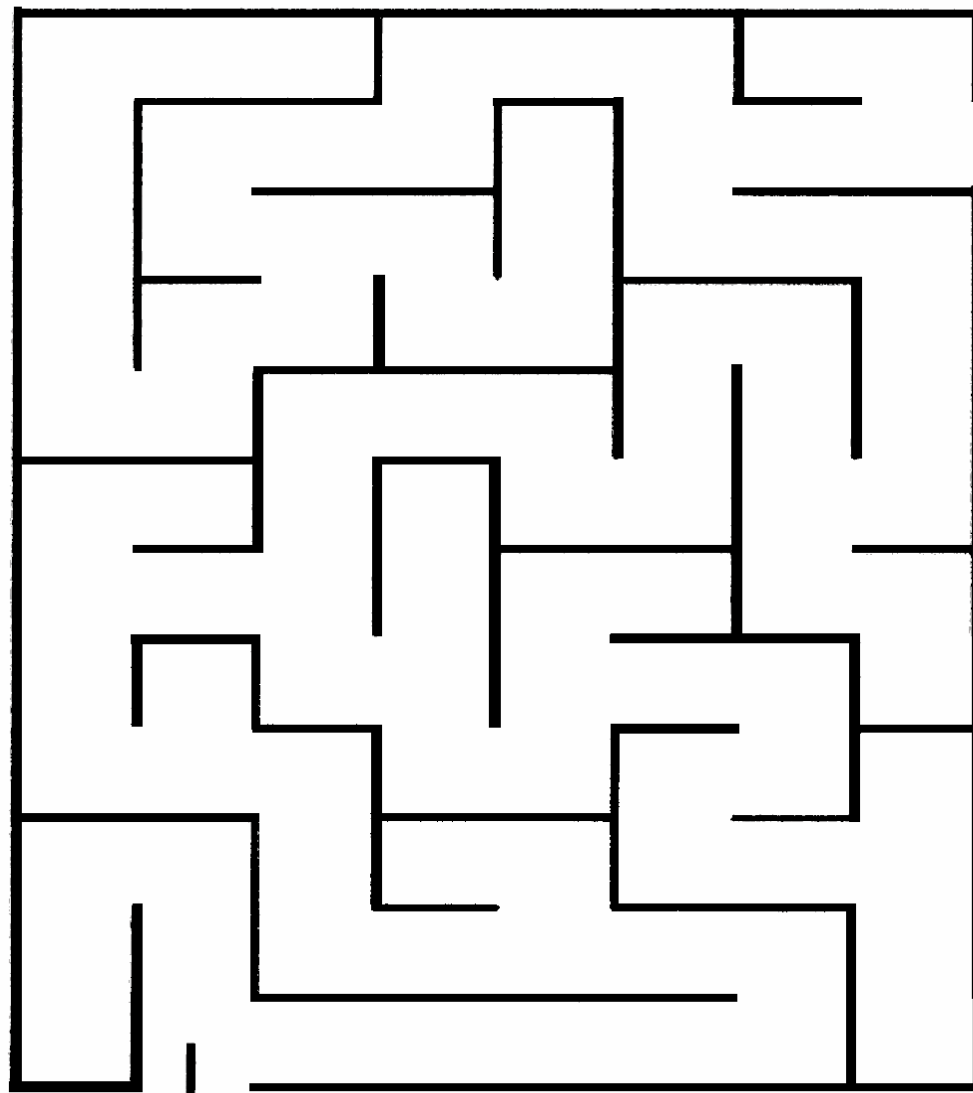

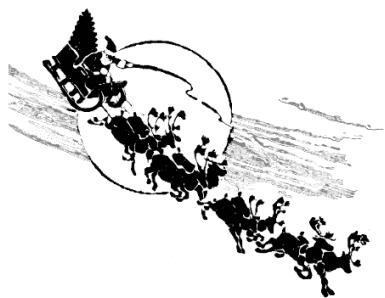
