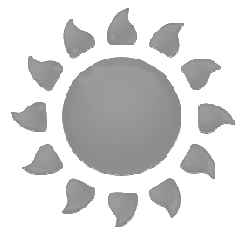
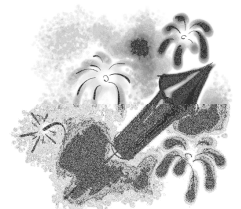
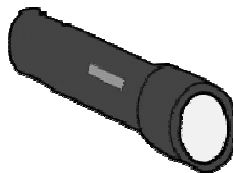
## Light Sources

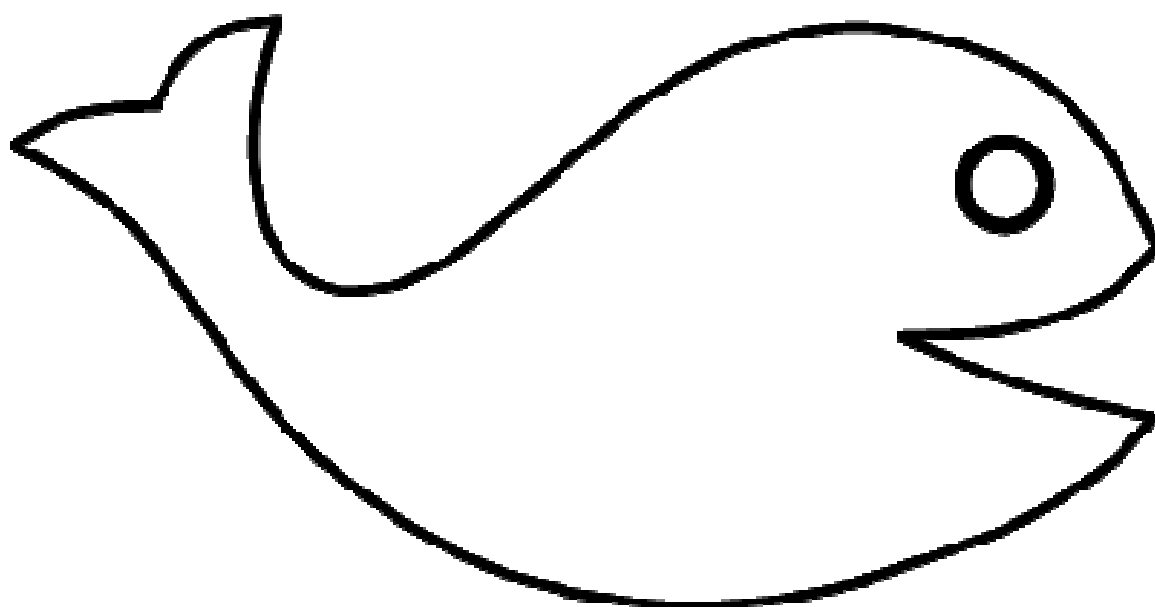

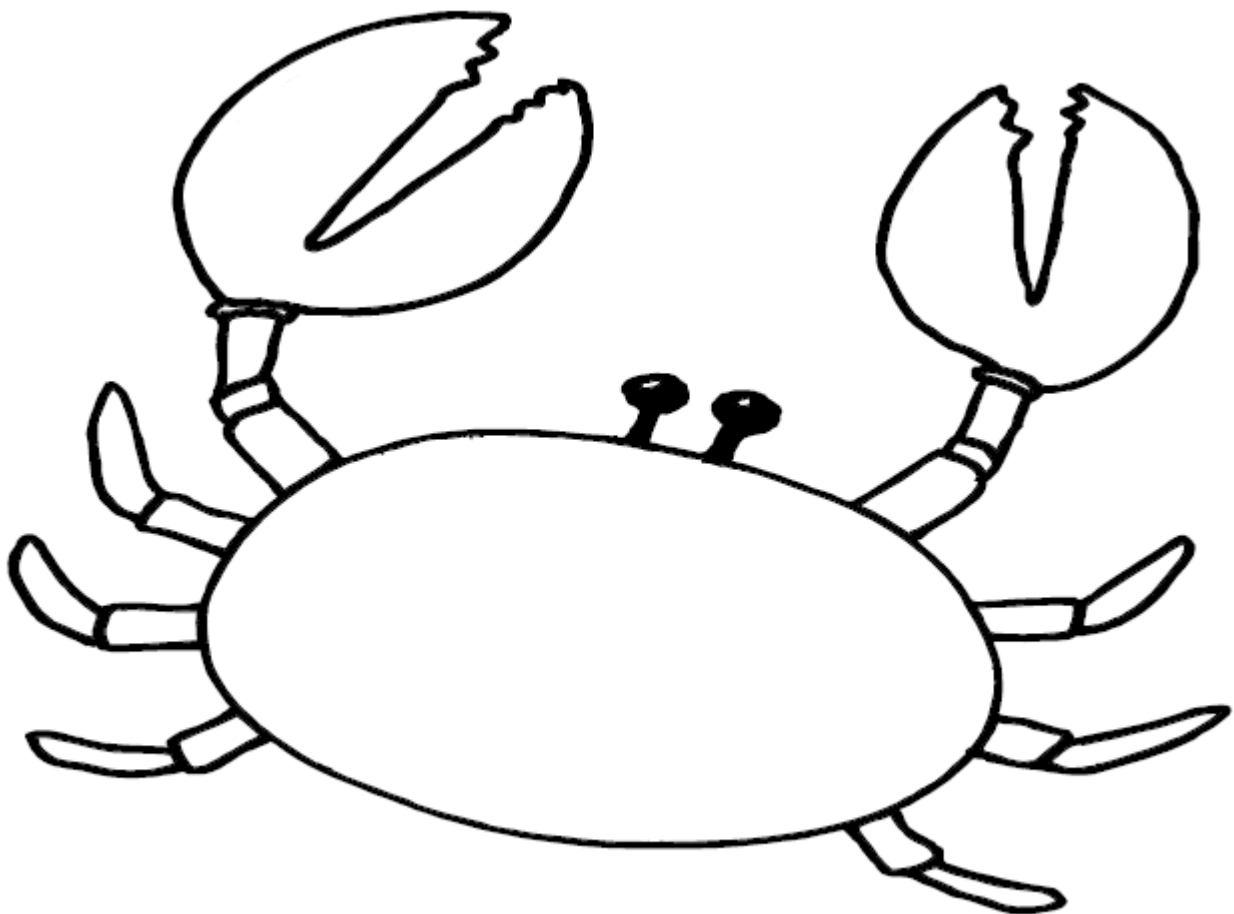
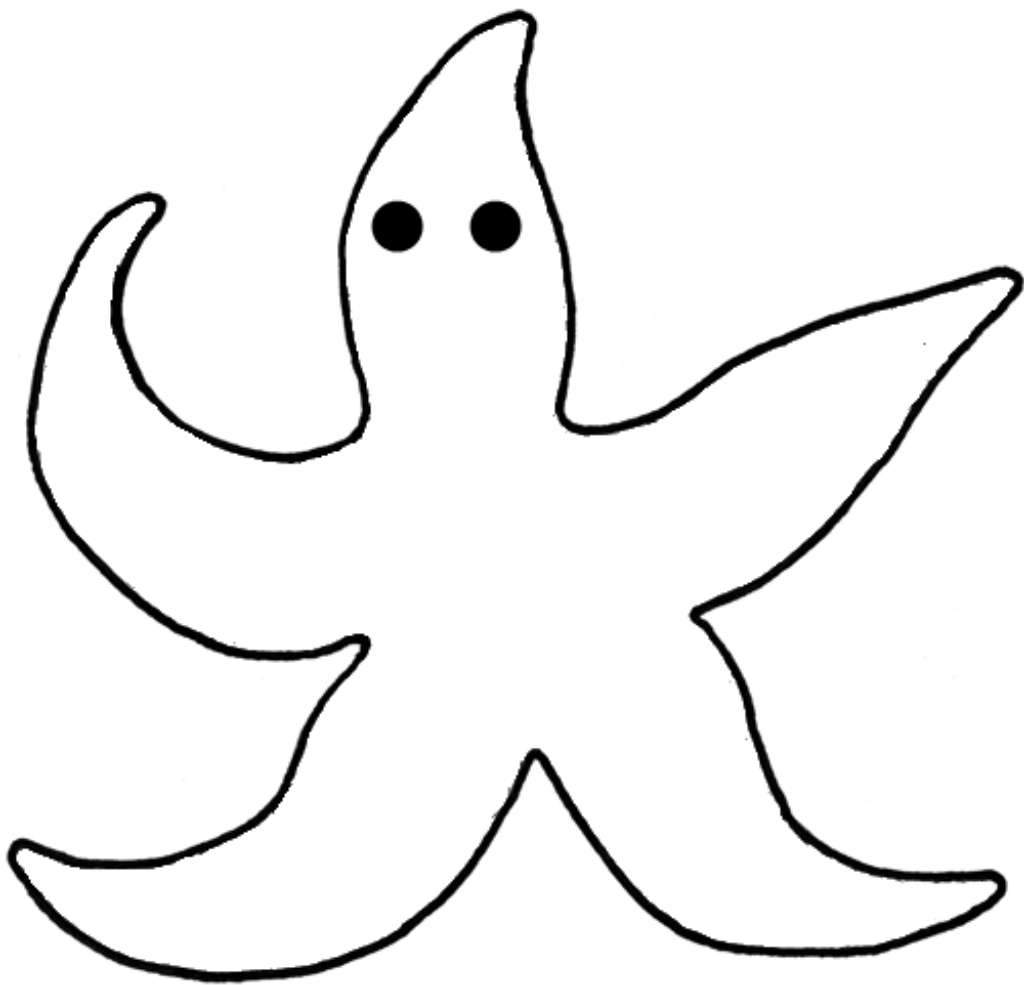
